PURPOSE:

JW3 is London's dynamic Jewish community and cultural centre. The purpose of this role is to provide a high-quality, consistent and structured programme of family focused arts, culture, community and participation events throughout the year. Building relationships with families, schools and partners to deepen and elevate our community reach and building JW3's next generation.

Brief

Family Sundays

- To programme, plan and deliver at least 12 family Sundays per year
- Engaging with a range of high-quality artists and facilitators to curate a programme of exciting and engaging work
- The programme will include a range of workshops and activities for children and families

Half term and holiday activities

 Build and grow a programme of events for children and families, working with the Programming team to think holistically about the offer for families across JW3

Festival days

- To programme, plan and deliver up to 4 festival days per year, responding to the Jewish calendar through arts, culture and participation
- These will include building on JW3's highly successful Party on Purim and Chanukah Funukah, as well as expanding into two new festivals.

Schools

 Support JW3 in building relationships and future projects with Jewish schools and community groups

General

- Work collaboratively with the Programming team to understand the wider programme and opportunities for collaboration
- Work with the Marketing team to support a new strategy and plan for promotion of the family programme
