


Job Description Head of Philanthropy

Thank you for your interest in joining JW3.

JW3 is the first and only inclusive Jewish Community Centre and cultural venue of its kind to exist in the UK. The brainchild of Dame Vivien Duffield DBE, the centre opened on Finchley Road, NW3 in October 2013, and has since become known as the home for Jewish culture and conversation.

Our vision is a vibrant, diverse, unified Jewish community engaged with Jewish life and contributing to wider society. Our mission is to create open and welcoming Jewish spaces that bring different people together, strengthen identities and build community through arts, culture, education and social action.

Over the past eleven years, we have increased the quality, variety and volume of Jewish conversation, both within our community and beyond. And in the past sixteen months, the critical need for our services, our programmes and our voice has reached unprecedented levels. About the Role

Purpose of Role

An important part of JW3's funding comes from high-net-worth individuals (HNWI) who support the charity on a long-term basis. As Head of Philanthropy, you will maximise charitable income through building strong and authentic relationships with existing and new major donors via the new patrons scheme. You will also be responsible for developing the strategy with the support of the Development Director.

You will be responsible for developing the HNW strategy with the support of the Development Director. This role will involve collaboration with the wider Development team and Board in order to deliver successful fundraising initiatives to reach targets. In particular, you will work very closely with the Donor Research Officer to grow the pipeline and arrange meetings with identified prospects.



Key Responsibilities

- Lead on the development and delivery of our HNW strategy, focussing on gifts between £5,000 and £50,000.
- Identify and build relationships with individual supporters and prospects, ensuring a consistent, healthy pipeline of new supporters via our new patrons scheme.
- Increase the number of major donors making regular donations (annual/multi-year) year on year.
- Employ a variety of personal engagement and communications mechanisms to ensure that prospects and supporters become, and remain, fully engaged with our cause.
- Research and identify new donors, logging all opportunities on our fundraising database and working with the Development Director to move them through the donor cultivation cycle.
- Analyse income of donations in-building and online, working with the Development Director to leverage fundraised income and engagement.
- Oversee the effective use of internal systems to ensure best practice in fundraising, data collection, gift aid and gift acceptance policy.
- Provide support as needed to the wider JW3 Development team, particularly at fundraising events – some of which will take place outside of standard working hours
- Develop and maintain detailed knowledge and information on JW3 services, projects and priority areas in order to keep donors updated.
- Represent JW3 externally, communicating the vision, values, and case for support to the wider community at appropriate external forums.
- Protect and enhance the reputation of JW3, representing the organisation in an appropriate and professional manner to stakeholders, acting as an advocate for the work of JW3.

- Extensive demonstrable experience of success in a relationship fundraising-focused /HNW role.
- Proven ability to 'make the ask' and engage confidently and effectively with a range of audiences (internal and external).
- Demonstrable experience of achieving income against targets.
- Experience of successful proposal and report writing.
- Strong interpersonal and influencing skills, with an ability to identify new donors, and develop effective approaches and cases for support.
- Experience of developing positive, effective relationships with trustees, collaborating successfully with lay committees and boards
- Excellent written/verbal communication skills, able to produce sensitively worded correspondence and ensure supporters feel valued and cared for.
- Strong presentation and numeracy skills.
- Highly organised, with efficient management of time and responsibilities and following through on plans/targets.
- Excellent attention to detail.
- Willing and able to work flexibly to meet the needs of the team and organisation.
- Ability to navigate competing priorities and manage timesensitive issues in a calm, professional manner.
- Proactive and solution-focused, with an ability to take initiative and a creative approach to problem-solving.
- Demonstrable understanding of the principles of Data Protection legislation, alongside other relevant legislation and guidelines within fundraising
- High level of IT proficiency (including Microsoft Office software), experienced in Fundraising/CRM software and databases.
